

### 01 FAMILY BACKPACKS

The great exploration begins at the SNFCC Receptions! Get ready to discover the SNFCC and the Stavros Niarchos Park through two themed backpacks full of creative activities and games for the whole family.

### 02 AGORA

The Agora is the best place to see everything that's happening at the SNFCC! It is where the National Library of Greece and the Greek National Opera meet and if you peek inside the building Foyers, you can spot Susumu Shingu's colorful floating sculptures. What catches your attention inside the glass buildings?

### 03 CANAL

Did you know that the Canal consists only of sea water? It is 1.5m deep, it is filtered and returned to the sea! In the summer, the Canal hosts many different events, while throughout the year, 59 vertical water jets and 10 swiveling fountains present themed choreographies daily, creating a spectacular sight. ### 04 SOUND GARDEN

Discover the Sound Garden, listen to the sounds of the sea or tell secrets through the Parabolic Reflectors! You can even try composing a family tune!

### 05 WATER JETS

The favourite spot of kids in the warmer months... No one can resist the fun offered by this hidden spot of the Park in the summer!

### 06 GREAT LAWN

The Great Lawn is the heart of the Stavros Niarchos Park -and who doesn't love playing on the grass! Find tasty treats at the food & beverage spots for a picnic and enjoy nature in the city.

### 07 PLAYGROUND

Kids only! Try the games for each age and play with all your energy and mood.

### 08 RUNNING TRACK

It's showdown time! Who will be crowned winner of the race and who will win at table tennis?

### ★ MAMAN, ESPLANADE

Louise Bourgeois's monumental sculpture *Maman* (1999) is presented at the Esplanade by NEON and the SNFCC, until November 2022. Standing at over 10 metres tall, the iconic stainless steel giant spider was the Tate Modern's first Turbine Hall commission in 1999, and was subsequently cast in six bronze replicas. As Bourgeois has stated, *Maman* symbolizes her mother, who wove and restored tapestries.


